4 Statistics Mean Median and Mode Problem Find the mean median and mode of the following data set 12 15 18 12 20 15 **Solution** Mean $\frac{12 + 15 + 18 + 12 + 20 + 15}{6} = 15.33$ Median Arrange the data in order 12 12 15 15 18 20 The median is the average of the two middle numbers $\frac{15 + 15}{2} = 15$ Mode The mode is the number that appears most frequently 12 and 15 both appear twice so the data set has two modes 12 and 15

5 Pythagorean Theorem Problem A right triangle has a hypotenuse of 10 cm and one leg of 6 cm Find the length of the other leg **Solution** The Pythagorean Theorem states $a^2 + b^2 = c^2$ Where a and b are the lengths of the legs and c is the length of the hypotenuse Substitute the known values $6^2 + b^2 = 10^2$ Simplify $36 + b^2 = 100$ Solve for b $b^2 = 64$ so $b = 8$ cm
