it is 1936 and boy willie arrives in pittsburgh from the south in a battered truck loaded with watermelons to sell he has an opportunity to buy some land down home but he has to come up with the money right quick he wants to sell an old piano that has been in his family for generations but he shares ownership with his sister and it sits in her living room she has already rejected several offers because the antique piano is covered with incredible carvings detailing the family s rise from slavery boy willie tries to persuade his stubborn sister that the past is past but she is more formidable than he anticipated

now a netflix film starring samuel I jackson winner of the new york drama critics circle award for best play this modern american classic is about family and the legacy of slavery in america august wilson has already given the american theater such spell binding plays about the black experience in 20th century america as ma rainey s black bottom joe turner s come and gone and the pulitzer prize winning fences in his second pulitzer prize winner the piano lesson wilson has fashioned perhaps his most haunting and dramatic work at the heart of the play stands the ornately carved upright piano which as the charles family s prized hard won possession has been gathering dust in the parlor of berniece charles s pittsburgh home when boy willie berniece s exuberant brother bursts into her life with his dream of buying the same mississippi land that his family had worked as slaves he plans to sell their antique piano for the hard cash he needs to stake his future but berniece refuses to sell clinging to the piano as a reminder of the history that is their family legacy this dilemma is the real piano lesson reminding us that blacks are often deprived both of the symbols of their past and of opportunity in the present

in this critical study mary I bogumil argues that wilson gives voice to disfranchised and marginalized african americans who have been promised a place and a stake in the american dream but find access to the rights and freedoms promised to all americans difficult the author maintains that wilson not only portrays african

americans and the predicaments of american life but also sheds light on the atavistic connection african americans have to their african ancestors
